## ITINERARY

**DAY 1 – FRIDAY, MARCH 2** Depart from Orlando. Connect with an overnight flight to London.

**DAY 2 – SATURDAY, MARCH 3 (LONDON)** Arrive at London Heathrow Airport in the morning. Transfer to hotel. Visit the British Library. Serving as the national library of the United Kingdom, the British Library includes over 150 million items. Among the items on public display in the Sir John Riblat Gallery are the Magna Carta, Leonardo da Vinci's notebook, the first collected edition of Shakespeare's plays, and manuscripts of the Beatles. Of particular interest in the Riblat Gallery for our visit will be early editions of biblical manuscripts, including Codex Sinaiticus and Codex Alexandrinus. Visit the Tate Modern Museum, which houses the UK's collection of modern and contemporary art from 1900 to the present day. Dinner together in a London restaurant.

**DAY 3 – SUNDAY, MARCH 4 (LONDON)** Visit the British Museum, home to one of the finest collections of art and artifacts from cultures—ancient and modern—throughout the world. During the visit, major attention will be given to archaeological artifacts related to the history and cultures of the biblical world, including such items as the Black Obelisk of Shalmaneser III, the Cyrus Cylinder, and a clay tablet containing the Epic of Gilgamesh. Afternoon free for sightseeing on your own in London. Dinner together in a London restaurant.

**DAY 4 – MONDAY, MARCH 5 (LONDON)** Visit the National Gallery. Located in Trafalgar Square, this museum houses Britain's national art collection. The museum's permanent collection contains more than 2,300 paintings from Western European artists dating from the mid-thirteenth century to 1900. Afternoon and evening free for sightseeing on your own in London.

**DAY 5 – TUESDAY, MARCH 6 (LONDON)** Free day in London to explore on your own. Dinner together in a London restaurant.

**DAY 6 – WEDNESDAY, MARCH 7 (PARIS)** Morning departure for Paris from St. Pancras Rail Station on the Eurostar high-speed train, which goes through the Chunnel under the English Channel. Arrive at the Gare du Nord in Paris and transfer by metro to our hotel. Afternoon visit to the Musée d'Orsay. Housed in a renovated train station built for the Universal Exposition of 1900 (which is itself a work of art), the Musée d'Orsay displays a variety of artwork (paintings, photographs, sculpture, architecture, and graphic and decorative arts) from 1848 to 1915. Artists whose works are on display include Monet, Degas, Renoir, and Cezanne. Dinner together in a Paris restaurant.

**DAY 7 – THURSDAY, MARCH 8 (PARIS)** Visit the Louvre, one of the most spectacular museums in the world, containing more than 35,000 treasures of paintings, archaeological artifacts, sculptures, prints, and drawings. Among its most famous objects are the Mona Lisa, the Victory of Samothrace, the Law Code of Hammurabi, and the Venus de Milo. Late afternoon and evening free for sightseeing on your own in Paris.

**DAY 8 – FRIDAY, MARCH 9 (PARIS)** Morning visit to the Louvre. Late afternoon free. Dinner together in a Paris restaurant.

**DAY 9 – SATURDAY, MARCH 10 (PARIS)** Free day in Paris to explore on your own. Dinner together in a Paris restaurant to complete our tour.

**DAY 10 – SUNDAY, MARCH 11** Morning transfer to Charles de Gaulle Airport in Paris. Return flight to Orlando. Late afternoon arrival in Orlando.

**PAYMENT:** A full deposit of \$300 per person is required. Final payment for trip, including optional insurance premium if applicable, is due NOVEMBER 27, 2017. Thereafter, a late payment fee of \$100 will be assessed.

**ACCOMMODATIONS:** Price is based on double occupancy. When available, single rooms are often smaller than doubles. If you request a single room, the following charges apply: \$450 during the tour.

**AIRLINE ROUTES and TICKETS:** In order to keep prices low, EOT does not guarantee the most direct routing to your final destination. Once "printed", airline tickets cannot be changed or refunded thereafter. Air transportation to/from your destination will be economy class on IATA and ARC carriers utilizing APEX or SUPER APEX non-refundable, non-amendable tickets for groups of 10 or more flying together on entire itinerary. If you choose to depart from a different city than your group or travelling companion, or deviate your flight and/or trip plans, and/or you are taking a pre or post tour, you may fly on a different scheduled flight(s) than the rest of your group.

**FLIGHT TIMES:** All flight times are subject to change by the airlines without advance notice. EOT is not responsible for such changes or delays and does not reimburse expenses resulting from such delays. If making own flight arrangements to departure city, we recommend you purchase a ticket which can be changed without large penalties.

**ITINERARY CHANGES:** Every effort has been made to ensure the accuracy of this brochure. While you will see all sites listed above, the order of sites and/or days and number of days may be altered to accommodate changes in airline, hotel schedules, and local conditions. If itinerary changes necessitate extra overnights, you will be charged \$125 per night; single rooms \$175 per night. Meals for extra nights are not included.

**CANCELLATION FEES:** 100% of Cancellation Fees are covered by the optional Travel Protection Program provided premium has been paid and reason for cancellation is insurable. Those who do not take travel protection should be aware of the following cancellation penalties: From day of registration to 105 days prior to departure, you will be charged the \$100 non-refundable administrative fee plus any airline fees. Additionally, thereafter, you will be charged any airline penalties and a single room supplement if your cancellation forces your roommate into a single, plus the following charges: 104-60 days = \$400; 59-45 days = \$600; 44-31 days = 40% of total cost; 30 days to day of departure = 100% of total cost. Submit cancellation in writing. On or after day of departure, no refund for any services not used.
